INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Instructions for use

- Put the gloves on dry, clean hands.
- Rub over the gloves stained with oil or grease using a dry cloth before taking them off.
- Inspect the gloves for snags or tears before reusing them.

Storage conditions

Store the gloves in their original packaging protected from light and humidity.

Laundering conditions

Caution : using the gloves or submitting them to a cleaning or laundering process which is not specifically recommended can alter their performance levels.

Drying conditions

Ensure the inside of the gloves is dry before putting them on again.
